WHAT ARE THE SELECTION REQUIREMENTS?

ELIGIBILITY:

You must fulfil all the following requirements on the closing date for applications:

- Be nationals of the Member States of the European Union or be EFTA citizens.
- Have successfully completed a post-secondary education of at least 3 years (minimum EQF 6 level): this includes Bachelor's degree, Master's degree, PhD, or equivalent qualifications; obtained within 3 years by the closing date for applications.
- Have at least C1 level of English.
- Have not already benefited from any kind of traineeship or employment (formal or informal, paid or unpaid) within a European institution or body for more than 6 weeks.

ESSENTIAL PRESELECTION CRITERIA:

- One of the qualifications above preferably (but not limited to) related to business/public administration, humanities, architecture, communication studies, or social sciences.
- Digital literacy and very good knowledge of MS Word and Excel.

DESIRABLE:

- Critical, analytical and synthetic skills.
- Ability to work independently and to show great attention to detail.
- Experience in teamwork.
- Knowledge of research methodologies and AI tools for data research and content analysis.
- Exposure to managing a project or a network with several members.
- Experience in preparing reports and short analytical extracts (preferably related to comparative education/vocational education and training policy).
- Use of mainstream social media.
